Respected Madam,

Sub:- Payment of pension arrears to MTNL pensioners for the period from 01/01/2007 to 30/09/2012 due to revision of pension.

At the outset I convey our sincere thanks to you on behalf of all the members of this Association for the decision of DOT to pay the arrears of pension on account of revision of pension.

We had a meeting with CCA Maharashtra Circle recently and discussed this issue of drawal and payment of arrears. It is gathered that the payment of arrears and issue of new PPO by CCA is linked up. Madam, the work of preparation of PPO is not picking up pace and at this rate of progress of work, it seems it may take more than an year to complete the PPO preparation for those retired up to 31/12/2006, for whom the arrears are due.

It is said that arrears will be drawn in staggered manner periodically as and when PPOs are issued. This procedure will lead to unfair and unequal treatment among pensioners, and the CCA office will be under pressure from all corners to issue their PPO first.

**Therefore we suggest that 95% of arrears may kindly be paid to all the pensioners immediately and to release the balance 5 % to those pensioners as and when their PPOs are issued. This procedure will be fair to all the pensioners and relieve the CCA office from undue pressure.**
